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


COMBINED BIOLOGICAL SCIENCE MEETING DETAILS

BOOTH INFORMATION



Image above is an example of our supplier's 2 x 2 booths.

Booth price for CBSM 2026 is **\$1300 for all booths**. Corner booths are available at the same price as an incentive for early commitment. Each booth will come with **one table**. There is a limited amount of additional tables available which we may be able to assign when finalising the layout. We reserve the right to modify the layout closer to the event in order to optimise the experience for both exhibitors and attendees. For this reason please make sure to indicate your preferred booth numbers in order of preference. Priority will be assigned by payment date.

All exhibition booths will be provided with power (one 5 amp power supply/booth) and rear and side panelling (two side panels for corner booths) measuring 2 metres wide x 2 metres deep. These will already be in place when you arrive. Panelling will be covered with front-runner, which is Velcro receptive.

Facia boards containing your company name will be *in situ* in your allocated booth along with a 1.5 metre trestle table, tablecloth and two chairs.

Allocation of booths is made on a *first come first served basis* on receipt of payment. We regret that no booths can be allocated or booked until payment is received. Payment may be made by:

Exhibitors are requested to wear their CBSM badge to enable them to be easily identified and to give them access to the refreshment areas.

Badges will be placed in your booth area or available from reception on arrival.
